General Guidelines and Regulation

The Students Competition of 16th Annual Congress of IADR, Iranian division, starts. All participants should be dental students and must send the required information by email, as explained below.

Requirements:

1. Abstract

- a. Terms and condition: Abstracts must be submitted on the understanding that they have **NOT** been presented or published elsewhere and are not currently under consideration by another conference. The submitting participant should ensure that all other co-authors have approved the abstract publication.
- b. • Abstract should **NOT** exceed **300** words.
- c. The abstract must be in English, font size **12** in Times New Roman font, and single-line spacing.
- d. In research or clinical study cases, the abstract must be based on the **original research** or original clinical case studies or their modifications, e.g., clinical trials, animal studies, and systematic review meta-analysis. **Reviews** are **allowed** for submission as a student competition. **NO case reports or case series** are permitted for submission.
- e. Suppose the abstract has been selected for presenting. In that case, the speaker automatically permits publishing the abstract in the 16th congress of IADR, Student Competition Program, and any further requirements will notify the participant.

2. Resume / C.V.

Please provide the following information as a standard resume:

- Core competences
- Professional experience (e.g. animal study assistant)
- Publications
- Presentations
- Awards
- Patents
- Additional credentials: Technical skills, professional developments, organizations.
- Both resume and SOP should be in English, font size 12 in Times New Roman fonts and with single-line spacing

3. Statement of Purpose (SOP)

- a. A good statement of purpose ranges from between 500-1000 words. Please do **NOT** exceed this limit.
 - b. Participants should explain their passion and purpose of being researcher as well as future interests.
 - c. Both resume and SOP should be in English, font size 12 in Times New Roman fonts and with single-line spacing

Deadlines and Other Inquiries:

- **NO** participation forms will be considered **after 26th November 2020.**
- Incomplete participation information and requirements will **NOT** be accepted as all required information should be received before the submission deadline.
- The draw process will select the competing participants based on score points. So, all the requirements and the presentations are impacted.
